

Youth Players Code of Conduct

As a Youth Player at North Ferriby Football Club I shall:

- Play by the rules, enforced by my manager or coach as well as my match day official
- - Not engage in aggressive or abusive behaviour towards anyone
- Play fairly alongside my fellow players and teammates
- Play to the best of my ability
- Understand what my manager is trying to implement within the team and follow his/her instructions to the best of my ability and knowledge
- Approach someone within the club with any information that I may believe to be important
- - Approach someone within the club about anything that I am worried about, within or outside of the game

As a Youth Player at North Ferriby Football Club I understand:

• If I do not follow the clubs philosophy implemented by my manager or coach, I may face being asked to leave the club

- If I engage in aggressive, abusive or racial behaviour I can expect to be fined, suspended or released by the club after an investigation
- - The club have the authority to suspend me at any time throughout the season, whilst I am signed on as a Youth Player
- - The club may also issue me with a written or verbal warning, of which my parents will be notified
- Any misuse of club facilities, including damage or not booking before use will result in an immediate fine

Please read, understand and comply with, this Code of Conduct ensuring that football at this club, under any level, can be enjoyed as much as possible.
